Guests slowly made their way to the Kevin Jones Camp Kitchen, where they were welcomed by the inviting aroma of fresh coffee and tea





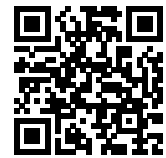

It's hard to say who enjoyed it more—the giggling adults attempting to hide eggs in the dark or the gleeful kids sprinting around in search of them.



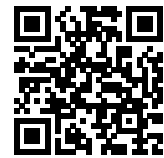


Firstly, the children were given clear instructions to find only four eggs each. Once all the children had collected their four eggs, they were to return to the camp kitchen together as a group.

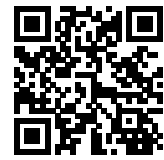
After a while, all the eggs were found, and everyone leisurely made their way back to their home away from home.
