

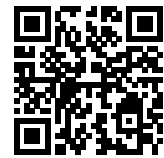
Farewell to a great man

To those guests yet to find our little piece of paradise, you will find samples of Brendan's humour all around the park.

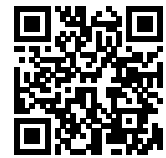
So, Happy Wanderers, come join me for a night or two and experience The Bearded Wonder's special touches around the park.
