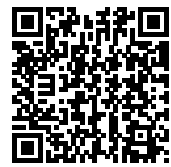


The Adventures of the Woof & Wanderers at Wyalkatchem Travellers Park

Following a relaxing morning tea, the group headed to Korrelocking Reserve for sightseeing and hunting for the elusive wildflowers.”







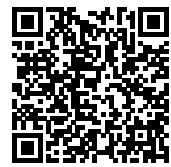

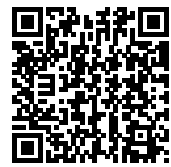
