



What an EGGcellent weekend



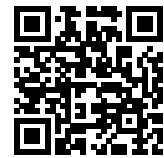
Easter weekend at Wyalkatchem Traveller's Park arrived in a heartbeat, and we couldn't wait to welcome our guests!

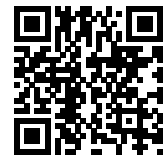

Easter Monday was filled with fond farewells as guests said their goodbyes and departed throughout the morning, taking wonderful memories of the weekend with them.

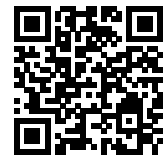
